

EXPECTED OUTCOMES: THREE & FOUR YEAR OLDS

SPIRITUAL

- Recognize that God is a loving God and He created the world
- Identify that Jesus is God's Son
- Identify that the Bible is a special book and it is God's Word
- Recognize that prayer is talking to God and they can ask for His help to take care of them

SOCIAL/ EMOTIONAL

- Enjoy and initiate friendships with a variety of individuals
- Share their ideas with friends and family
- Use language to express self, developing positive conflict resolution
- Develop self-confidence in self-initiated activities
- Begin to exhibit self-control
- Communicate effectively using their words
- Demonstrate independent and responsible behavior

PHYSICAL

- Participate in rhythm and movement activities
- Explore fundamental movements through time, activities, and equipment available
- Acquire and develop fine motor skills
- Be introduced to health and nutrition

COGNITIVE

- Engage with others in learning activities, including the ability to explore, create, experiment, observe, plan, analyze, reason, investigate, and questions
- Enjoy creative expression
- Use imagination in dramatic play centers and find creative solutions to problems that arise during center play

LANGUAGE & LITERACY

- Identify the language as English and illustrate its use in different environments
- Have a desire to look at books that have text and illustration
- Have cultivated prewriting skills in the context of literacy
- Awareness of different sounds of letters

NUMERACY

- Apply math vocabulary, concepts and participate in directed activities
- Perform appropriate counting, sorting and comparing skills
