Yes! It's been a month since enrichment classes began and in the month of September, Preschool focused on their *beat and rhythm*. They learned a lot of new songs and played percussion instruments to practice their beat and rhythm. This October, preschool will continue practicing their beat and rhythm and will start learning about *tempo*.

For Elementary Music, the introduction song lyrics are **“God made the music, God made the music, when He created symphony”**. We started our music class by recognizing where it came from and continued learning about sounds or music coming from nature. Students also tried creating symphony by mimicking sounds from the nature. 2nd and 4th graders had extra lessons on musical symbols, the locations of the notes and a review of their beat and rhythm. This month of October, students will dig deeper to the elements of music (beat, rhythm, tempo, dynamics, and more) and will apply what they learn.

Physical Education: Preschool are enjoying their 2 days of P.E each week and I look forward to seeing them stronger physically at the end of this school year. K-1 and 2nd-4th grade had a class dance exercise performance in September 30. Videos will be uploaded this week.
