



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

STEP 1: SCHEDULE SCHOOL TOUR

Make an appointment by calling the office or sending an email.
Appointment times are available on weekdays mornings.

STEP 3 SCHEDULE AN INTERVIEW

Upon completion of the application submission, an interview with the child and parents will be scheduled with the School Head, to sign on the Parents contract. Preschool students 4 years old and above will be evaluated on English ability (speaking and listening). Entrance exams are administered to students in grades 1-5.

STEP 4 Class observation scheduled and teacher interview.

STEP 5 START DATE DETERMINED

Elementary children, 5 and up, attend only 5 days per week. Once you have determined the days your preschool-aged child attends there will be no change of days until the following school year. Yes, you may add days as your child adjusts the school, if there is space available.

CRITERIA FOR ENTRANCE:

The following will be used as a basis for selecting children to attend the school: age, class size, English language proficiency, siblings enrolled at the school; English language support at home by a parent or guardian and ability to benefit from an English education. Though not required to be Christians, the parents of students in YCS should have a clear understanding of the Biblical philosophy and purpose of the School. Based on the entrance exam some students may be admitted to a grade lower than anticipated and asked to attend additional language class by school. Our goal is the long-term success of the student in an academic environment as opposed to automatic promotion based on age.

The School Head makes the final decisions on admission, and grade level placement and any additional tuition assistance (if required). Admission will be confirmed by the final confirmation email from the School Head to the parents.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

❖ The Tuition and other fee are due in full within 10 days of the invoice sent /before your child starts class (whichever applies).
